

Uddin Wins Case Report Award

Naseem Uddin, M.D., was presented with the Case Report Award at the Society for Pediatric Pathology 2023 Fall Meeting. His report entitled “Chronic granulomatous disease with abnormal RBCs: a manifestation of contiguous genomic deletion” was recognized at the October meeting in Portland, Oregon.

The award is open to any presenter including medical students, pathologists-in-training, junior or senior pathologists, and clinical or basic science investigators. No formal application or nominations are necessary.



UT Southwestern fellowship-trained in Clinical Cytogenetics and Pediatric Pathology, Dr. Uddin has been a faculty member in the Pathology Department since 2013. In 2007, he was the winner of the Society for Pediatric Pathology Resident Recruitment Award.

The Case Report Award holds a value of \$250.00.
